



Hiring your wedding **PHOTOGRAPHER**

Look at past weddings on their website. DO YOU LIKE THE PHOTOS?

There are lots of different wedding photography styles, but what matters is that you like the look of the photos. Remember, you can't change a photographer's style!

Book a photographer who offers an engagement shoot.

Test them out. Get comfortable in front of the camera.

Do you like this person?

They will be by your side for the entire wedding day, you **MUST** feel comfortable with them!

Know exactly who will show up shoot on your wedding day.

What's the backup plan in case of illness or accident?

What is their working style?

Will they try to blend in? Take charge and pose moments? Lay across the floor of the aisle?

Check out packages.

Don't need everything? Ask about their flexibility, maybe with time limits, finished shots, or eliminating albums and prints you can have made yourself.

Will you own the digital copies?

Can you provide a shot list of of specific things you want photographed?

Ask for a list of references

Do a Google search for reviews on Yelp, Facebook, and other online forums.

GET IT ALL IN WRITING. Never book a vendor who won't give you a written contract for services!
