



Hiring Your Wedding Vendors

1. Go to a bridal show and talk to vendors in person.

Eliminate vendors who you don't "click" with, or who don't fit your budget.

Get detailed info about pricing + availability for your area.

2. Ask smart questions about pricing and packages.

Some useful questions to ask potential wedding vendors:

"My budget is \$XXXX. What can we do within that budget?"

"What can we substitute or eliminate from this package so that it would work with \$XXXX budget?"

3. Be aware that online vendor guides are paid ads.

A generic google search will give you more thorough + inclusive results.

ADDITIONAL THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

Most expensive does not equal highest quality!

Ask your friends + family for referrals!

AT LEAST a phone call is critical if you can't meet in person.

Are you comfortable with them? This is someone you're going to have to interact with a lot in the coming months!
